FUTURE DAYS BRINGS TOGETHER ACADEMIC AND SOCIOECONOMIC EXPERTS FOR SHARING AND DEBATES AROUND THE THEME "LEGACY AND FUTURE OF OUR CITIES"

On 27 and 28 November 2019, the third edition of FUTURE Days at Cité Descartes in Marne-la-Vallée will see 7 round tables, 10 talks, 4 workshops and 11 visits of research facilities around the theme "Cities: our legacy, our future". Bringing together the academic and socioeconomic worlds, the event is marked by the participation of experts and international figures involved in the city and sustainable development.

Patron of FUTURE Days 2019, **Patrick Boucheron**, a French historian, is also chairman of the Scientific Council of the École Française de Rome and professor at the Collège de France. A specialist in Medieval and Renaissance history, he is Chair of "History of the Powers in Western Europe, 13th-16th Centuries". He recently stated, "There is no such thing as lost time, but there is no time to lose.".
